"ese animals grazed an area, moved to new grass and did not return to previously grazed ground until the grass fully recov-ered. in holistic management grazing, grassNization and new methods, most attempts to improve the management of land in the third world have failed. there is a history of frustra-tion, problems, waste of resources, unsustain-able projects, populations that refuse to partici-pate in programs that violate their true desires, and occasionally conflict that has led to blood-shed.
