Median nerve compression (chronic sx, affects thumb/2nd/3rd and 1/2 4th fingers, worse in am, patient feels need to "shake out hands" to improve blood flow, weakness and atrophy late findings); ulnar nerve compression (chronic, sx radiate down to 1/2 ring and index finger, often worse at night/in am); radial nerve compression (typically associated w/trauma at proximal humerus or prolonged Pathophysiology and etiology the basic pathophysiology of paresthesias is an altered nerve or nerve pathway function. paresthesias are thought to represent abnormal showers of impulses generated from an ectopic focus 3 and can arise from an abnormality anywhere along the sensory pathway, from the peripheral nerves to the sensory cortex. 4 paresthesias can be caused by central nervous system or Driving faqs – when can i drive after my surgery? can i drive? you must hold a valid drivers licence for the vehicle you plan to drive. you must be able to control your vehicle in an emergency situation.
